Project Update

As you may or may not be aware the City of Lewiston was awarded a Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) grant from the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) in the amount of \$640,000.

The City originally applied for this grant in November 2017, but was not awarded the grant at that time and the project moved forward with only local funds. In the fall of 2018 the State Legislature allocated additional funds to LRIP grant program and MnDOT re-evaluated the projects that were not awarded funding previously. In this round of funding the City of Lewiston was awarded the grant funds.

In order to take advantage of this funding MnDOT required the City to cancel the contract that they had with A-1 Construction and re-bid the remaining work using MnDOT guidelines.

Presently, the remaining work has been removed from the A-1 contract. A-1 has some minor work remaining and they are responsible for maintaining the site until the new contract is awarded. The new plans are being reviewed by MnDOT for compliance with state standards. Upon MnDOT approval the project will be advertised for bids.

Anticipated Schedule

Bidding: May 2019

Construction: June – July 2019 with completion to be in early August.

This schedule is subject to change as there needs to be agreements executed between the City of Lewiston and MnDOT prior to starting construction. These agreements do not get started until the plans have been approved by MnDOT. Future newsletters will be sent when the project schedule becomes clearer.
