The contractor finished installing water and sewer main from Highway 60 to 5th Street. Service installation has begun in the alley near the VFW. Service installation to homes will continue on Red Wing Avenue over the next week.

Following the completion of sewer and water services Wencl will begin installing storm sewer and preparing for road construction in the active work area.

With the recent rain, access has become more difficult. Efforts to maintain access to the extent possible are being made, but please use good judgement when traversing the project area.
